REACH Statement

REACH is a European Union Regulation concerning the Registration, Evaluation Authorization and restriction of Chemicals. It came into force on 1st. June 2007 and replaced a number of European Directives and Regulations with a single system.

The main aims of REACH are to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment from the risks that can be posed by chemicals, the promotion of alternative test methods, the free circulation of substances on the internal market and enhancing competitiveness and innovation.

REACH applies to substances manufactured or imported into the EU in quantities of 1 tone or more per year. Generally, it applies to all individual chemical substances on their own, in preparing or in articles (if the substance is intended to be released during normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use from an article).

CUC Engineering A/S is a manufacture located inside of the EU.

However, CUC Engineering does not use, manufacture or sell Articles containing chemicals that are intended to be released under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. Therefore, CUC Engineering does not intend to pre-register or register any substances, since pre-registration is not required under these circumstances.

CUC Engineering has contacted its suppliers (located inside and outside of the EUR) in an effort to obtain the information pertaining to any Articles containing SVHC's. So far none of these suppliers has given us any indication of them being subject to REACH.

Should any responses from our supplier indicate any implications with regard to REACH, CUC Engineering will pass this information on to you.
